BOIL WATER ADVISORY

TO CONSUMERS OF THE TOWN OF THESSALON WATER SYSTEM RESIDENTS ON:

Main Street (north of Park Street), River Street (north and south of Highway 17), Case Street, Boyle Street, Elliott Street, Peachey Street, Boundary Road, Gordon Street, Sydney Street, Highway 17 (#12724 and #12722), Green Lane, Station Road (McDougall Fuels and Transfield).

Algoma Public Health is advising the above residents to bring water to a boil before using it for domestic purposes. The water should not be used for the following purposes without first bringing it to a rapid rolling boil for at least one full minute: drinking, making infant formula and juices, cooking, making ice, washing fruits and vegetables, and for dental care. For these purposes, boiled water or commercially bottled water should be used. If there are children in the home, place the pot on the back burner to avoid scalds. Parents of very young children that may be inclined to swallow water during bathing are advised to consider sponge baths using commercially bottled water.

The reason for this advisory is that a high risk repair is underway to replace a main. There is a significant potential for contaminated water to enter the municipal water system.

This advisory will remain in place until such time as repairs have been completed and satisfactory laboratory test results have been obtained. Residents will be notified when this advisory is no longer required.
