

**THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF HURON SHORES**

**BY-LAW # 12-XX**

BEING A BY-LAW TO STOP UP AND CLOSE AN UNUSED PORTION OF INGRAM ROAD, WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF HURON SHORES.

WHEREAS Section 34 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001 c. 25, as amended, delegates authority to Municipalities to stop up and close highways including all road allowances it has jurisdiction over as deemed desirable;

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the Municipality of Huron Shores deems it expedient to stop up and close an unused portion of Ingram Road pursuant to the provisions of the *Municipal Act*, being that such portion is no longer required for the purposes of the Corporation;

AND WHEREAS a Notice of Intention to pass the proposed By-Law has been published in *The North Shore Sentinel* for 2 (two) consecutive weeks and posted on the Municipal Website;

AND WHEREAS no one has made claim that their lands would be prejudicially affected by the proposed stopping up and closing of the said section of unused portion of road, to the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Huron Shores;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Huron Shores ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. All of the portion of Ingram Road in Land Registry PIN 31446-0292 described as follows is hereby declared stopped up and closed:

That Part of Ingram Road described as Lot 28 RCP H-787 also described as Parts of RCP IR- , as shown on Schedule A attached hereto and forming a part of this by-law;

2. This By-Law shall come into force and effect immediately upon final reading, the passing hereof and upon registration of this By-law at the Land Registry office according to Section 34.1 of the *Municipal Act*.

Read a first, second and third time and passed in open council this 27<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2012.
