

**NOTICE OF THE PASSING OF
A SITE SPECIFIC ZONING BY-LAW
AMENDMENT IN THE TOWNSHIP OF GLADSTONE
WHICH IS NOW PART OF
THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF HURON SHORES**

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of The Corporation of The Municipality of Huron Shores passed By-law # 13-28 on the 22nd day of May, 2013 under Section 34 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990 as revised.

AND TAKE NOTICE that any person or agency may appeal to The Ontario Municipal Board in respect of the by-law by filing with the Clerk of The Municipality of Huron Shores not later than the 18th day of June, 2013, a notice of appeal setting out the objection to the by-law, the reasons for the objection and the fee required by the Municipal Board.

Only individuals, corporations and public bodies may appeal a by-law to the Ontario Municipal Board. A notice of appeal may not be filed by an unincorporated association or group. However, a notice of appeal may be filed in the name of an individual who is a member of the association of the group on its behalf.

No person or public body shall be added as a party to the hearing of the appeal unless, before the by-law was passed, the person or public body made oral submissions at a public meeting or written submissions to the Council or, in the opinion of the Ontario Municipal Board, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.

The purpose of the by-law is to amend the zoning designation from Seasonal Residential to Rural Residential while maintaining setbacks established in By-law # 09-60, from Bright Lake on the severed and retained lands being properties located in Part of Lot 10 Concession 2 Gladstone Township.

A copy of the By-law, along with Schedule "A" showing the affected properties, is attached.
