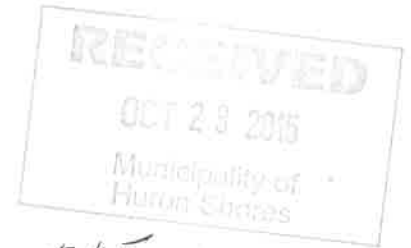


Iron Bridge Historical Museum

New Business:

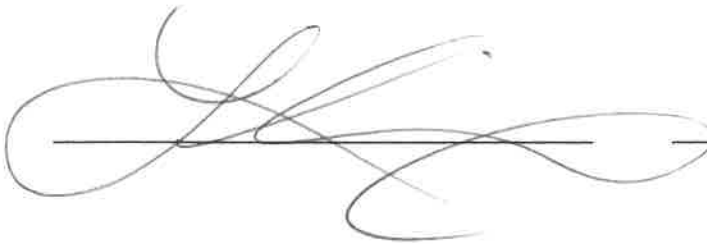

along with the picnic tables. The planter boxes need to be replaced. Overall, it was reported as a good year. **CLOSED**

Old Business:

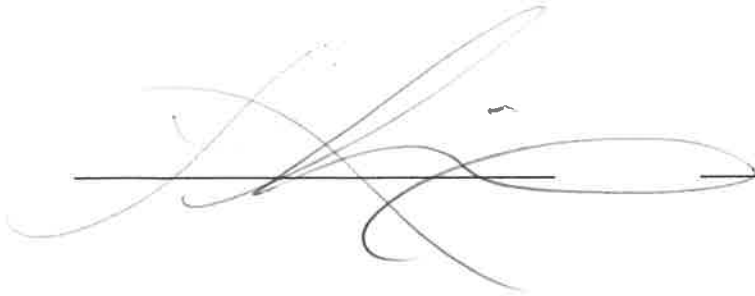

- One pine tree was removed from the Museum property while the Birch trees were not removed. The reason for not removing the Birch's is still to be determined. Mr. Ouimet recommended that a cluster of three birch trees be removed in addition to the originally scheduled trees. **Open**
- Stat Holiday Open Policy was discussed. No reason was identified for not being open other than stat holiday pay policies. Deferred until spring. **OPEN**

New Business:
