**Huron Shores' Understanding of the Negotiations
Regarding the Thessalon First Nation Boundary Claim**

Dated March 7, 2018

1. Ontario and Thessalon First Nation are currently the parties at the Thessalon First Nation Boundary Claim negotiations table.
2. Huron Shores is not involved in the negotiations and settlement of the land claim itself, other than in a consultative role to offer the negotiating parties perspectives on land usage, and evaluate impacts on the Municipality. Huron Shores is not, and will not, be a participant in the negotiations.
3. The negotiations are conducted on a confidential basis.
4. Huron Shores is not privy to the negotiation proceedings.
5. Huron Shores will not be signatory to the Boundary Claim settlement documents.
6. The negotiating parties will request information from, and consult with, Huron Shores regarding issues affecting the Municipality and property owners.
7. Public consultations will be held to gather input from interested parties and property holders.
8. These public consultations will be scheduled and facilitated by Ontario.
9. Crown land uses such as trapping rights, property access, logging and land leases will be addressed in the boundary claim negotiation and consultation process.
10. Private property, and existing access to private property, will not be affected by the Boundary Claim.
11. Property owners will continue to pay property taxes to, and receive municipal services from, the Municipality of Huron Shores.
