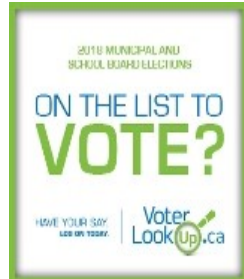
Municipality of Huron Shores Fall 2018 Newsletter ELECTION NEWS:

REPORTING TO THE CARETAKER
