ZONING AMENDMENT

Mayor Reeves declared the public meeting open in order to hear comments in support of, or objections to, the proposed zoning amendment to **reformat** the Comprehensive Zoning By-law and add a **housekeeping clause**.

4-1. P. Tonazzo, RPP, Planning Consultant – Report re: Reformatting of Comprehensive Zoning By-law #18-18

Mr. Tonazzo's report, detailing the minor changes and wording of the housekeeping clause added to the Comprehensive Zoning document, was provided to Council.

Mayor Reeves advised that he will allow a few minutes for anyone else to arrive who might wish to provide comments.

Mr. Bazil Seabrook joined the gallery at 7:05 p.m.

Clerk/Administrator Tonelli reported that Deputy Clerk Roberts has flagged a few minor discrepancies in the reformatted document; i.e. definition for 'bunkie', the text "Bunkie, see 'sleep cabin'" is missing. These discrepancies will be addressed with Mr. Tonazzo and amended, as necessary. She also noted that a few sections have been relocated in order to fall more in line with their references within the document; the text within the clauses themselves remain unchanged. Council instructed that there is no need to go through each of the discrepancies. Councillor Jones-Scissons noted some numbering changes but, will contact staff with any specific concerns found.
