

GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR COMPLIANCE

FOR COOKING OR WARMTH

Municipality of Huron Shores

- The property owner shall have at the location of the fire adequate individuals and firefighting equipment to control the fire.
- The fire shall not exceed 1 meter in diameter.
- The property owner shall keep the fire at least 5 meters from any combustible structure or material (trees, grass, piles of wood, etc.)
- The property owner shall not leave the site of the fire, until the fire has been completely extinguished.
- The property owner shall be responsible to determine if restricted fire zone conditions are in effect.
- No burning will be permitted with gusty winds or wind speeds greater than 16 km/hr.
- The property owner assumes full responsibility for all damages of every nature and kind which may arise as a result of the fire set by the property owner and irrevocably agrees to indemnify and save harmless the Municipality from any claims made against the Municipality of Huron Shores in consequence of damages arising from the fire set by the property owner.
- Any costs and expenses incurred by the Municipality or any Provincial Authority in controlling or extinguishing the fire set by the property owner shall be paid by the property owner.
- Every person who fails to comply with the terms above is guilty of an offence under the Forest Fire Prevention Act., and/or the Ontario Fire Code and upon conviction is liable to a fine or to imprisonment as provided in the said legislation.
