



QUILT PROJECT DETAILS

The Timber Village Museum Community Quilt Project is open to anyone wishing to participate. The TVM will welcome submissions from participants of all ages and geographic regions that have a tie to the Blind River & Area community. We want to see panels from our cottagers (we miss you!), students from near and far, as well as current and former residents. Family, individual, community group, and class submissions are also welcome. Make a panel as a family activity, or have everyone in your home make their own. Not a sewer? Not a problem!

Feel free to iron-on, paint, glue, or practice your stitching. Submissions should be **12" x 12"** square fabric panel designs using any fabric resource you have available. Deconstruct old clothing, blankets, you name it. Just have fun with it!



You may include your initials within the inner **10" x 10"** area of your panel, but no names in the design please. Ensure outer edges allow for sewing panels together. If the design goes to the edge of the square, some of it may be lost in the sewing process. Panels do not need to be quilted at the time of submission.

Please gently pin a piece of paper with your name, address, and phone number to your submission so we can keep track of all entries. If you would like to remain anonymous in the final product, please make a note with your information.

Panels will be accepted until **May 3rd, 2021.**
