## Notice of Public Education Session #1

### Huron Shores Flood Risk Assessment

#### The Project

Hatch Ltd. is in the process of completing a Flood Risk Assessment for the watershed within the Municipality of Huron Shores. This assessment will identify high-risk flood areas within the Municipality and will provide recommendations for continued studies in flood mapping and mitigation under the Government of Canada's Natural Disaster Mitigation Program (NDMP). The NDMP was established to reduce the impacts of natural disasters such as floods on Canadians.

#### The Process

The Flood Risk Assessment will identify areas most at risk of flooding by analyzing data from diverse sources including field surveys of local conditions, hydrologic and hydraulic analyses, historical flood data, and local knowledge. Public knowledge of past flood events is highly valuable in informing studies of this type.
