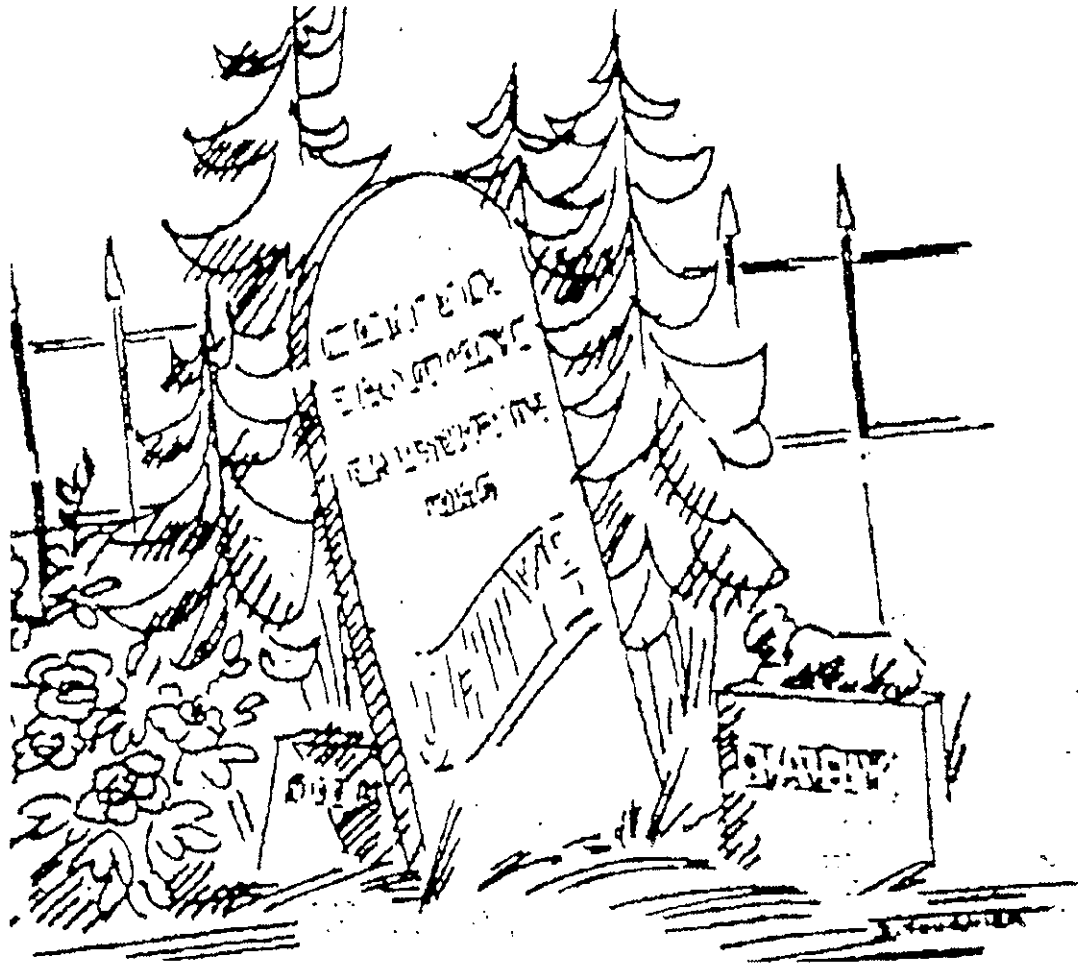

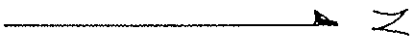
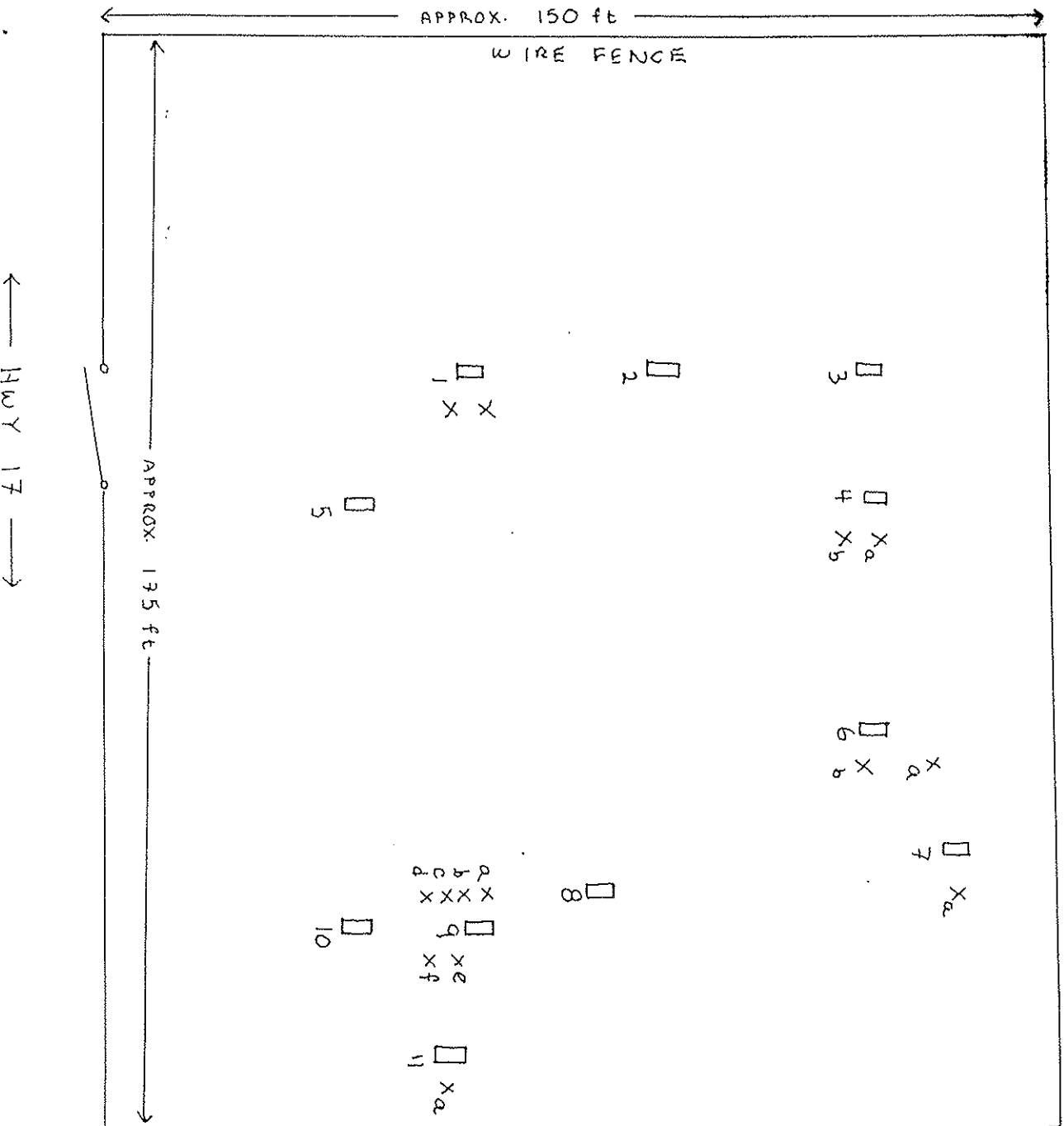
DIRECTIONS: The Cemetery is on Highway 17, about 18 km east of the town of Thessalon, which is itself, 86 km east of Sault Ste. Marie. The Cemetery is at the top of a steep hill on the north side of the highway, immediately east of Harris Creek, which crosses the highway at the bottom of a long dip in the road. It is opposite the end of ~~Day~~ Road, which runs south from Highway 17 at Harris Creek. *DAYTON*

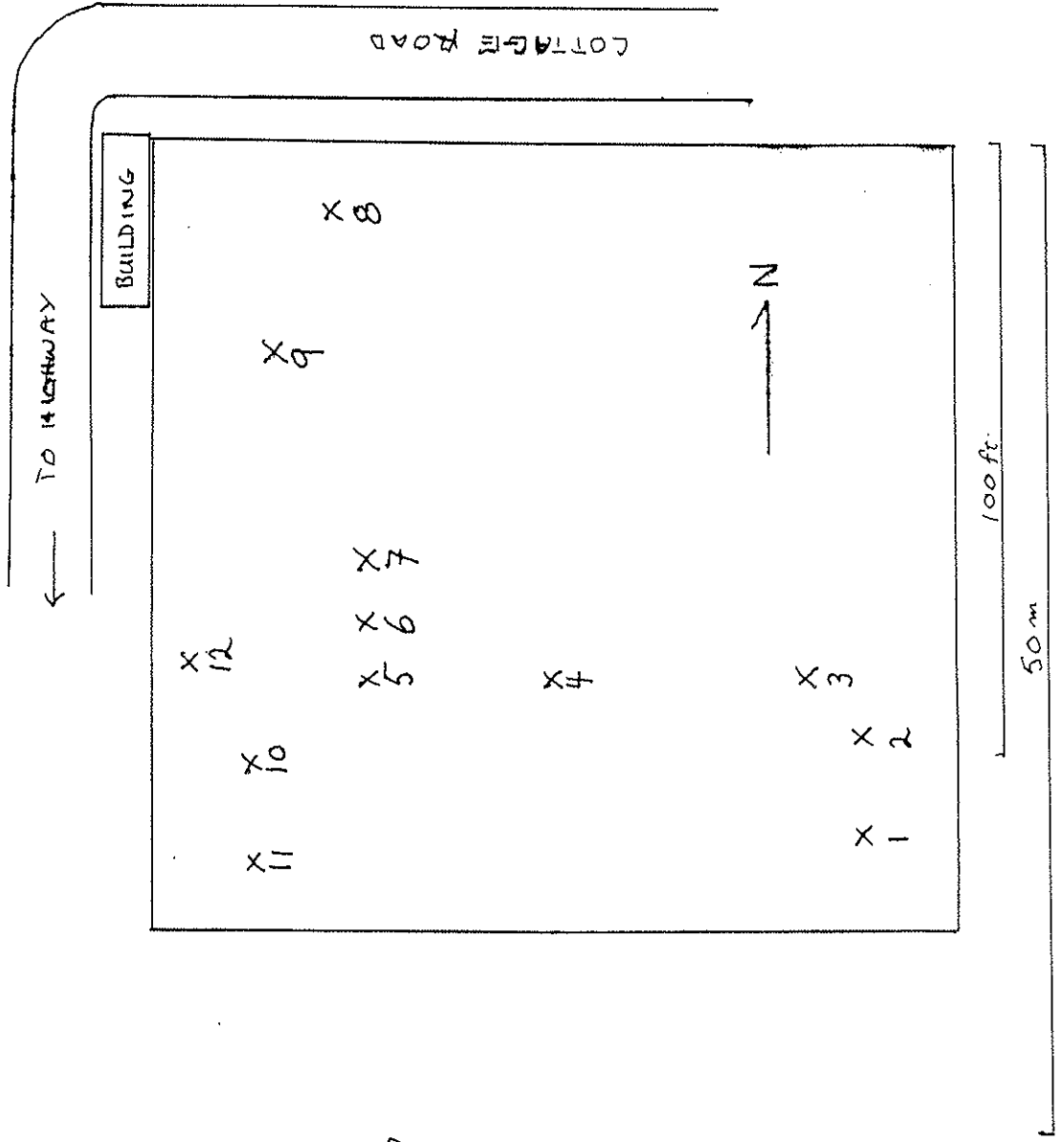
DIRECTIONS: From Sault Ste. Marie, travel east on Hwy. 17 to the town of Thessalon, about 86 km. Go on another 18 km to where the highway crosses Harris Creek. Day Road runs south from the highway here. Continue for about another half km up the hill. Turn left (north) off the highway on Pioneer Road, part way up the hill. Continue along this cottage road to its end near Basswood Lake. The cemetery is to the south of a private cottage in the woods. A tall stone (# 8) is close to the cottage driveway and readily seen, but the remainder of the stones are difficult to see when the leaves are out. Permission from the cottage owners to park nearby is readily obtained. There is no parking available on public lands.
